Now in its 65th season, the **Atlanta Symphony Orchestra** is the largest arts organization in the southeast, performing more than 200 concerts each year to a combined audience of more than 500,000 people. With a record number of 26 Grammy Awards and 6 ASCAP awards, the orchestra is noted for its impressive list of recordings and the excellence of its live performances.

The Atlanta Symphony Orchestra is available for performance to communities throughout Georgia. Performances may include the entire 95-member orchestra or a chamber orchestra dependent upon the size of the venue. Repertoire can include classic compositions of the masters and/or more contemporary pieces; programs run approximately 2 hours. Additional activities such as pre-show talks or conversation with student groups or others may be available dependent on schedule and personnel.



In addition to classical concerts, the ASO presents family concerts, an annual summer festival, outdoor summer music series at Chastain Park Amphitheater and Verizon Wireless Amphitheatre at Encore Park, holiday concerts, and free parks concerts. Its education and outreach programs reach more than 50,000 youth annually.
