

# D'vine Patriotic, Inspirational & Gospel Music Trio

The women of D'Vine sing a cappella and with accompaniment. For sixteen years, they have traveled the world delivering songs that linger in the hearts of audiences long after the trio has left the stage. The National Endowment for the Arts described their voices as an "American Masterpiece."

The trio has left their mark on major world events including the opening of the 1996 Olympic Games. They have also recorded numerous radio and television commercials for worldwide media representatives. In 2004, they were invited to perform at the Olympic Torch Relay for the Athens, Greece Olympic Games.

D'Vine has shared their voices in Brazil, Mexico, Argentina, Chile, and throughout Europe. Recently, the group performed throughout Ontario and Toronto, Canada. They also made their debut appearance in San Pedro Sula and Tegucigalpa, Honduras at the request of the United States Embassy. In addition to concerts for political officials and communities, D'Vine performed for the students and faculty at the University of San Pedro Sula and at the National School of Music in Tegucigalpa.

Performances and motivational/educational presentations are customized according to the audience and are adaptable for all age groups and cultures. Venues include schools and college assemblies, health care facilities, conferences, community theaters, senior citizen centers, correctional institutions, corporate settings, as well as formal settings with orchestras. Concerts include a combination of a cappella and music accompaniment via compact disc playback or symphony orchestra. Songs include patriotic, spirituals, gospel, and inspirational music. Presentations can feature both educational and entertainment components. Performance length and content varies and is adaptable according to the anticipated audience, venue, and overall objective of the presenter. General public concerts are usually presented in a 90-minute performance with a 15-minute intermission or on 45-60 minute performance of uninterrupted music. Presentations for schools, hospitals, and senior citizens centers are generally thirty to forty-five minutes and are usually booked in conjunction with a general public performance.
