He is a Harvard University graduate and has an MFA in Theatre from the University of San Diego. He was named National Storyteller of the Year 1999 and has performed in more than 70 professional theatre productions around the country.

Mr. Mann's performance programs are varied, interactive, accessible, and fast-moving. He offers a wonderful combination of entertainment and educational value to engage every audience member (colorful props, puppets, costumes, and masks; simple music and song and full audience participation).

Programs include: The Living Labyrinth: A-maz-ing Myths from Ancient Greece, fanciful retellings of favorite myths; Peace Pipes and Talking Leaves: Cherokee Leaders and Lore, mix of history, culture & folklore of the people of North Georgia; Shakespeare's Fun House, age-appropriate introduction to the works of the great poet-dramatist; Mr. Bugaboo's Bugazoo, whimsical exploration of bugs and children's literature for emerging readers; A World of Stories, folklore and narratives from around the world; and Un Mundo de Cuentos, bilingual tales from Spanish-speaking cultures.

Mr. Mann is happy to collaborate with teachers and shapes classroom experiences through myriad approaches, including improvisation, creative dramatics, playwriting, oral interpretation, reader's theatre, media literacy, acting technique, storytelling, theatre games, video production, creative writing, and full theatrical production. Barry delights in working with audiences and students to discover the insights and joys of drama and story, and to explore, "anything involving words and images."
