His Bluegrass/Jazz/Country crossover group was featured in the nationally syndicated PBS Network series, *Hocking Valley Bluegrass*, and have been highlighted in Bluegrass Magazine. His hands-on workshop includes a performance with the above mentioned instruments, a historical synopsis of the instruments, singing and audience participation in a variety of activities.
