



The Art of Georgia III. Celebrating Home

ABOUT THE PROGRAM:

The Office of the Governor in partnership with Georgia Council for the Arts is pleased to announce a call for entries for *The Art of Georgia III: Celebrating Home*. This third iteration of the exhibit is the culmination of a five year program that celebrated original works of art created by Georgia artists. Since 2012, 289 works of art by 209 artists have been exhibited at the State Capitol.

The Art of Georgia III: Celebrating Home seeks to capture the uniqueness of communities throughout Georgia as seen, explored, and depicted through the artist's eye. Two-dimensional visual art, in a variety of media, exploring this theme will be considered. The exhibit will hang in the executive offices of the State Capitol and showcase current work of contemporary Georgia visual artists. Three-dimensional work and film and video instillations are not eligible. This is not a professional, juried competition. Pieces will be selected by Georgia Council for the Arts and the Office of the Governor. All decisions are final.

ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES:

Work is being sought from contemporary Georgia artists, ages 18 and up, currently residing in Georgia. The initial call is for work from artists residing in North Georgia (see map below). The call for entries will subsequently be issued in South Georgia. Each region has its own deadline; please see below for the submission date and the detailed county list. Please pay particular attention to the year work is being sought in your region. Entries must explore the theme of the rich diversity and uniqueness of Georgia's communities. Interpretations of the theme (geography, people, landmark, landscape, etc) are encouraged. Painting, drawing, photography, printmaking, and mixed media are all eligible. Three-dimensional work, film and video are not eligible and will not be considered.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

- No more than three entries per artist
- All entries must be emailed to gaarts@gaarts.org with "The Art of Georgia III" as the subject
- Images must be submitted as a jpeg attachment and cannot exceed 72 dpi
- Submit your work according to the deadline that corresponds with your home county
- Each image must be titled with the artists name followed by the name of the piece
- In the body of the email be sure to include the artists name and complete contact information (address, county of residence, phone and email) as well as the following information about each piece of work: title, medium, dimensions, year completed
